
Audrain County Cemeteries

Only stones remaining are listed here. Five stones used as a support for an outbuilding were found on a farm approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the cemetery.

MALONE, Susan E. wife of George A. died 24 Oct 1877 33 y 9 m 9 da
