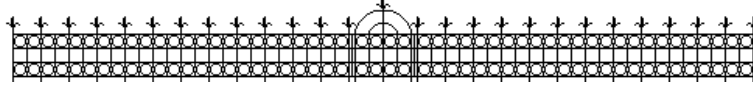


## Audrain County Cemeteries



