ST. BRENDAN'S CATHOLIC CHURCH CEMETERY, MEXICO, MISSOURI



St. Brendan's Catholic Church Cemetery is located on the east side of Elmwood Drive, one-half block north of West Liberty street. It is well maintained and is currently in use (1996).

A petition to form a Cemetery Association of the St. Brendan's Catholic Church was presented to the Audrain County Circuit Court on October 4, 1886, by E.J. Dempsey., President, Thos. P. Roden, Secretary and D.E. Shea, Treasurer. Some dates on tombstones indicate that that were interments there much earlier than 1886.
