Wesley Chapel Church Cemetery is located
NW ¼ NW ¼ SEC 7 T52N R7W. Church was first called Unity and is still sometimes known as Unity. From Mexico, 10 miles north on StRd J
to CoRd #457, north 2 miles to intersection of CoRd #458 and CoRd #480. Cemetery is on southeast corner.

FEGAN, J.E. 2 Feb 1833 – 24 Mar 1893

Mary E. his wife 2 Apr 1836 – 19 July 1909

Believed to have been removed and reinterred at Elmwood Cemetery, Mexico, Mo.
