Sec. 27 T52N R6W. Large cemetery, about 6 miles east of Scott's Corner (intersection of US Hwy 54 and State Hwy 19) on State Hwy BB, to County Rd. #649, then north on County Rd. #649 to County Rd. #618, then east on private road to field. To access this cemetery, one must walk to north edge of field in brushy area. No recent burials. All stones were pushed over by 3 wheelers several years ago. Notes. Mrs Hulen added some history of this cemetery and in remarks, she says, "Here lie my great, great grandparents, James and Catherine Mulberry Fields, many great aunts and uncles, my grandfather, Greenberry Fields, and perhaps my grandmother, Alice Fields. However, at the present time her grave has not been found."
