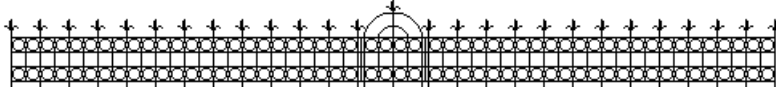




Littleby Baptist Church Cemetery
