1884. State of Mo. vs Silas Smith et al (Henrietta Redman, Julia Glover, Ann Crockett). Arson. Burning of the colored Baptist Church. Silas Smith was reared by Asa Faulks of Tennessee. Asa Faulks' sons, Wm. A. Faulks and Jas. H. Faulks served with the Confederate army in the 4th Tenn. Regt. of (prob) Co. A. Silas Smith went with them as a servant all through the war until Spring 1865. Contains an account of the activities of Silas Smith until he came to Mexico, Mo. about 1881. Names Jane Gay, Rich Glover, Sarah Faucett, Enos Jackson, James and Rachel Bryant, Helen Nickens, Burgess and Dennie Washington, Lizzie Nichols, Jemima Brown, George Redman, Harriett and Perry Thomas, all early members of the colored Baptist church as were the defendants.

Audrain County Circuit Court 1890.

Till #540 File 13. M. Williams vs. The School District of Laddonia. Petition in Mandamus. Plaintiff says that there are in Laddonia and within the school district 15 or more colored children resident and that the school district has failed to establish a separate school for them as required by law.

Audrain County Circuit Court. 1890.

Till #540 File 14. M. Williams vs J.C. Delaporte. Writ in Mandamus. Pltf. says that defendant was appointed to the Board of Directors of the school district of Laddonia to enumerate the colored children of school age within the district. One colored child, to wit, Soonie Cosby, was intentionally omitted from the enumeration in order to keep the number below 15, that the law might be evaded.



Compensation Claims

What was a Slave Compensation Claim?

During the Civil War, two acts of Congress—one passed in 1864 (13 Stat. 11) and one in 1866 (14 Stat. 321)—allowed loyal slave owners whose slaves enlisted or were drafted into the U.S. military to file a claim against the Federal government for loss of the slave's services. The law allowed for up to \$300 compensation for slaves who enlisted, and up \$100 for slaves who were drafted. Although a third act of Congress passed in 1867 (15 Stat. 29) suspended the claims process, paperwork created by this claims process has survived.

Filing a Claim

The slave owner filing a slave compensation claim had to prove his or her

- · loyalty to the federal government
- legal ownership of the slave

Nichols Obituary

Negro Woman Noted for Cooking, Dies. "Aunt" Lizzie Nichols Had Worked in Spence Home Continuously 31 Years

Daily Intelligencer Jan. 6, 1911 p1 c4 & 5

"Aunt" Lizzie Nichols, 56 years old, one of the town's most highly respected negro woman died Thursday night on her way home from Mrs. A.K. Spence's residence where she worked. She stopped in at the home of Amelia Johnson in East Mexico and, while there, died suddenly of heart trouble. "Aunt" Lizzie has worked for Mrs. Spence continuously for 31 years. She was noted for her good cooking in the Spence home where she had presided in the kitchen for nearly a third of a century. She was reared by James A. Nichols, of West Monroe street, whose name she bore after the fashion of old slave times.

It was many years ago in Boone county when Mr. and Mrs. Nichols were married that Lizzie, then a little slave girl, was given to them by Mr. Nichols as a wedding present. She remained with the family for many years after the war when the Negroes were freed.
